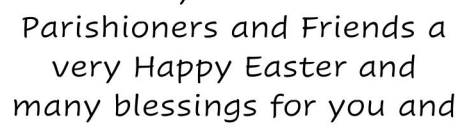

As you can imagine, hope is much needed at the moment for the Christians in the Holy Land. The tragic events that started on October 7, 2023, have brought many disastrous consequences, including greatly increased need for support for the Christian community. Most of our faithful rely on the pilgrimage industry to make a living.

After two years of pandemic, during which no pilgrims could reach the Holy Places, Christians in the Holy Land were just starting to recover their debts when the war broke out.

Now, once again, they find themselves without a source of income. People need support for everything, including medicine, surgeries, and food. Fear and despair are very strong. Christians now represent less than 2% of the population down from 23% a century ago.

Each year the Holy Father asks every Catholic parish around the world to take up a Collection on Good Friday to keep a Christian presence in the Holy Land. Your support is essential to help the Church minister to parishes, provide Catholic schools, and offer religious education. The Pontifical Good Friday Collection also helps to preserve the sacred shrines of Christianity, including in Jerusalem, Nazareth, and Bethlehem.
