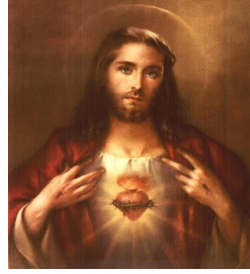

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

(September to May)

Children, ages 3 to 9, have opportunity to participate in Children's Liturgy of the Word at the 11:30 am Mass.

The children will hear the Word of God in a way that speaks to their age level and participate in an interactive homily.



Anyone who plans to have their child baptized is asked to call the Rectory (215 465 4050) to make arrangements.

Parents are required by Canon Law to attend a Pre-Jordan Class prior to the Baptism. These classes will take place at the Rectory by appointment only. Baptisms may be held on any Sunday once the Pre-Jordan Class is completed.



BAPTISM

Sponsors for Baptism and Confirmation: Anyone asked to be a God-parent/Sponsor should contact the Rectory regarding their Letter of Eligibility. Requirements to obtain a Letter of Eligibility to be a Sponsor for the Sacrament of Baptism/Confirmation

- ◆ At least 16 years of age and a parishioner of Sacred Heart
 - ◆ Received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist
 - ◆ Attend Mass every Sunday as well as receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once a year
 - ◆ If married, married according to laws of the Catholic Church
- Eligibility letters are obtained after meeting with Father Mahoney or Father Welsh. Please call the Rectory with your contact information and one of the priests will reach out to you to schedule a meeting.



Holy Matrimony

Couples must contact the priest at least six months prior to the intended wedding date. All couples are required to attend premarital instructions in preparation for marriage.

Anointing of the Sick: In case of serious illness or advanced age, please call the Rectory (215 465 4050) to receive the Anointing of the Sick.

- St. Oscar Romero - obsessive-compulsive disorder
- St. Thérèse of Lisieux - modern day anxiety, scrupulosity, and depression
- St. John of God - hospitalized due to a mental health crisis
- St. Mark Ji Tianxiang - substance use disorder

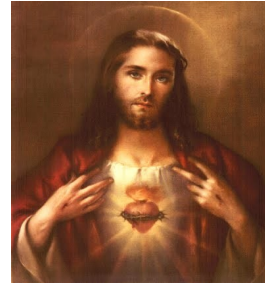
