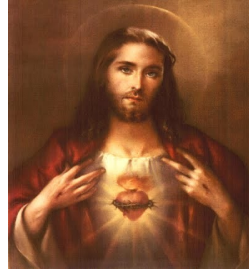

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

(September to May) Children, ages 3 to 9, have opportunity to participate in Children's Liturgy of the Word at the 11:30 am Mass. The children will hear the Word of God in a way that speaks to their age level and participate in an interactive homily.



BAPTISMS—Anyone who plans to have their child baptized is asked to call the Rectory (215 465 4050) to make arrangements. Parents are required by Canon Law to attend a Pre-Jordan Class prior to the Baptism. These classes will take place at the Rectory by appointment only. Baptisms may be held on any Sunday once the Pre-Jordan Class is completed.

Sponsors for Baptism and Confirmation: Anyone asked to be a Godparent/Sponsor should contact the Rectory regarding their Letter of Eligibility.

Requirements:

- ◆ At least 16 years of age and a parishioner of Sacred Heart
- ◆ Received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist
- ◆ Attend Mass every Sunday as well as receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once a year
- ◆ If married, married according to laws of the Catholic Church

Eligibility letters are obtained after meeting with Father Mahoney or Father Welsh. Please call the Rectory with your contact information and one of the priests will reach out to you to schedule a meeting.

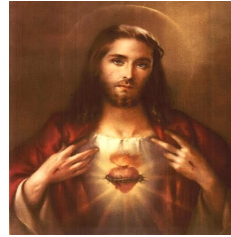
